- 8. Fire Chief's Report Chief Dan Padilla reported that the District responded to the following calls:

Vegetation Fires – 1
Structure Fires – 4
Other Fires – 4
Traffic Accidents – 3
Medical Calls – 27
Hazardous Conditions – 1
Public Assists – 6
Total - 46

Chief Padilla reported that he completed a FEMA grant that would provide 100% of the funding for 4 firefighters for 3 years. The average age of the District's firefighters is 57, and the District would benefit from recruiting and retaining new firefighters. FEMA issues the grant as "fully loaded" to capture all costs associated with employment, so the District should plan to add up to \$1.2 million over the course of 3 years to our budget projections for payroll. Chief Padilla noted that housing issues related to high number of short term rentals in the community makes a challenge to draw in new employees and this grant could help incentivize growth for the District.
